Johnny Cash.....*God's Gonna Cut You Down* 2:00

Cash's musical career spanned several decades, all of which he utilized in drawing inspiration for his own songs, and recording his versions of his favorite tracks. Often times, later in life, these songs were old-fashioned spirituals and gospel songs, like I See A Darkness, a favorite on our show. This song comes from gospel/soul legend Odetta.

Eddie Vedder.....*One Step Up* 3:00

We're not the only ones fond of music by Springsteen. The Boss was one of Vedder's inspirations growing up. This tune, from Springsteen's 1987 album **Tunnel Of Love**, was recorded in a **Demo** session Vedder did in his early years as front-man for grunge and alternative icon Pearl Jam.

The Sounds.....*Ego* 2:44

Indie alternative/ new wave rock from this band out of Sweden, this song is fresh off their album **Dying To Say This To You**.

University Of Coloardo Buffoons.....Landed 4:10

Fans of the TV series Sing-Off recognize Ben Folds as an a Cappella expert. This song is one of Folds' hits, found on a collaboration album he did with other singing groups called **Ben Folds Presents: University a Capella!**

Brandi Carlile.....*Heaven* 3:30

This alt-country sensation and Appetizer favorite's 2010 **XOBC EP** contained 3 original songs and two covers, including this song originally made famous by Bryan Adams.

Johnny Cash.....*Ain't No Grave* 2:53

The title track to the 2010 release by the deceased country legend was originally written and recorded y Claude Ely, who can be heard as a backup vocalist on this version.

William Fitzsimmons.....*You Can Close Your Eyes* 2:35

One of William's musical inspirations and influences growing up in a home with two blind parents was folk icon James Taylor. In 2009, Fitzsimmons released two **singles**, one of them this cover.

Diane Birch.....*What Is Love* 3:34

A song that became famous and popular as Chris Katan and Will Ferrell bobbed their heads to the side on Night At The Roxberry, this version of the Hadaway hit retranslates the club tune into a jazz ballad. This tune is found on her **iTunes Session EP**.

Acoustic Hits.....*Elevation* 2:50

Mostly known as a cover band, Acoustic Hits has albums that cover Michael Jackson, Def Leppard, and other pop hits. This version of U2's hit is, appropriately, found on their **Tribute to U2**.

Jeff Beck.....*Over The Rainbow* 1:00

The electric guitar legend's recent album **Emotion & Commotion** shows off Beck's prowess and interpretation of non-rock classics.

Obadiah Parker.....*Hey Ya!* 4:28

Listed as Various Artists, this Bossa Nova version of the disco hit from the Bee Gees can be found on the album **What A Difference....the Greatest Hits of Disco**.

Glee Cast.....*Jump; I'll Stand By You* 3:57; 3:52

Fans of the hit TV show are turning their ears to the soundtracks of the seasons, mostly cover songs from our favorite tunes. Covering 80s legends Van Halen and The Pretenders, both of these great covers are found on the **Vol. 2** soundtracks to Glee.
